Additional work is being carried out to finish non-stop water supply system in Bakuriani

In Bakuriani, Georgia, two water-related projects are being carried out: to provide a non-stop water supply system during the winter season and to increase water debit. Deputy Minister of Infrastructure, Ilia Begiashvili and the Director of Water Supply Company, Giga Mandaria, visited the places where works are being executed.

"We have two contractors in Bakuriani, both of which have different tasks. One of them is to add wells to the systems - we add approximately 5 wells; the other task is to rehabilitate and build a head water collector facility. Water was flowing to this old facility from nearby cricks which were lost to this day because it was in a bad shape. We will finish the work by October and by that time water debit will be increased in Bakuriani. Active planting and artificial snow projects are underway which will fully satisfy the resorts' pressing water needs,"- said Mr. Begiashvili after overseeing the works in place.

The cost of the project is 23,018,818 Georgian laris. According to the Ministry of Infrastructure, Bakuriani's water demands are fully met at the given moment, though dry climate, new infrastructure projects, many visitors and tourists tightened usual the water demands.

"Drinking Water is full of moss and fleas" - when will the problem be solved in the village of Matani?

The village of Matani is one of the denselypopulated areas in Akhmeta municipality. Kakutsa Cholokashvili, Georgian national hero, was born there. 5 000 people reside in this village. It is well-known that this village had drinking water problems for decades. The village residents say that in sunny weather drinking water is OK but after the rain, water comes brownish, smells heavy and is polluted. The village of Matani gets drinking water from the river Alazani. Village residents suspect that drinking water is mixed with irrigation water which is a problem. Village resident latamze Garsheulishvili says sometimes worms come from the tap and they do not drink the tap water. They buy drinking water in the supermarkets or take clean water from the spring which is in the centre of the village. "There were worms in the drinking water. When we told the village municipality representatives, they said we had to prove we were not lying ... They said they also drank the same water. If we go somewhere, we take bottles to fetch water back home." There was a verbal conflict between the village residents and mayor's office. David Mamukelashvili claims that more than 7 million GEL was allocated to resolve this problem. The tender is announced and the works will start soon which will continue for two years. "The tender will be over on August 22. The whole system will be renovated. Water head facilities will be refurbished and water will be chlorinated. This project will start in September and will be over in two years!," - Mamukelashvili told Radio Free Europe.

RMG continuing its environmental projects, bringing pikeperch back to Georgian waters

Since 2017, RMG has been actively working on the modernisation of the historic enterprise in terms of technological upgrades, labour safety and environmental measures. The 2018 - 2020 environmental programme by RMG through the intervention of the Ministry of Environment and Agriculture of Georgia, has almost addressed the environmental issues related to productions within the Bolnisi district. These include large-scale water, soil and ambient air protection measures, much of which had already been carried out by the company. RMG has set the record for several successful projects in regard to protecting the watery environment followed by steps taken towards restoring the biodiversity in regional rivers. The best example of this is the joint project of RMG and Wildlife magazine, which aims to foster the reproduction of pikeperch in Georgian waters. The joint project of RMG and Wildlife magazine aims to reproduce one of the most prominent representatives of ichthyofauna in the rivers and lakes of Georgia (Lucioperca - a family of perch). Since the start of 2019, several scientists, international foundations and foreign experts have been contributing to the project, which has finally made it possible to import the fish from Azerbaijan to Georgia. After obtaining the necessary permits and licenses, through the assistance of the Ministry of Environment and Agriculture, up to 1,000 small containers of pikeperch were imported on a trial basis, which was handed over to the National Wildlife Agency where Georgian and Azerbaijani scientists will conduct scientific experiments. In the second stage of the project, in order to ensure the long-term reproduction of pikeperch, the so-called "mother group" was imported, which enables the reproduction of millions of hatchlings in Georgian rivers over the years. The mother group had been split in two, one being placed in the lakes of Debeda and the remainder in Lake Admiral in Khashmi.
